Corporal Williams was previously with the St. Thomas detachment as a provincial constable.

Regular dentist discontinued

The regular services of a dentist in co-operation with Dental Assistant's Courses in Peel County will be dispensed with next September.

The Vocational Advisory Committee of the Board of Education in Peel decided last week on the advice of the Halton-Peel Dental Association that instruction by a dentist every week was unnecessary and that students would gain as much from occasional visits by members of the dental association on a rotation basis.

Three-car crackup

Three persons were injured Friday in a three-car crackup on Highway 10 north of Derry Rd.

Percy Williams, 24, of 53 Ardglen Dr., Brampton, was stopped in the southbound lane waiting to make a left-hand turn when his vehicle was struck from behind by a car driven by Jan Sikora, 40, of 86 Centre St., Brampton.

The Williams car was pushed into the northbound lanes and struck by a vehicle driven by Norma Hawes, 50, of 65 Martha St., Bolton, Ont.

Williams was admitted to hospital with pelvic injuries. Norma Hawes

suffered fractured ribs and knees, and Cathy Slade, a passenger in the Williams car, received lacerations and a broken arm.

Provincial Constable Murray Gregory estimated damages at \$4,200.

Driver training in school

Driver education will again be available in Peel County secondary schools.

The board of education has approved a program for the year 1969-70.

Two courses are now scheduled - October to December inclusive and February to May inclusive, with a summer course also being considered.

Each course will include six hours driving, 12 hour in-car observation, and 25 hours classroom instruction for each student.

About five schools in Mississauga and three in the former Central Peel district will hold courses.

The fee will be \$50 per student.

Two killed in May

During May in Peel County, the Port Credit detachment of the OPP investigated 137 property damage accidents, 22 personal injury accidents with 34 persons injured and a total property damage of \$125,360.

Two fatal accidents occurred with two people killed.

A total of 98 charges were laid as a result of accidents.
