a tributary to the South boundary of the Parcell
Indian Reserve who have been for many years
using the trail as means of access to the 4th
road running across the Parcell Reserve & thence
the said 4th road through the reserve has
now been fenced cutting off our means of access
& necessitating a great inconvenience in getting
to our market town Calgary. We do hereby
petition the Department of Indian Affairs to
use its influence to arrange with the Parcell
Indians for a surrender of sufficient land
for a public roadway from the end of Twp.
22. between ranges 2 & 3. to the main trail
(Government) a distance of only $\frac{1}{2}$ a mile which
will save us between 12 miles
