Under date of February 2I, I92I we received the following by mail: "So far \$20,000.has been invested in equipping this mine with "machinery and making slopes, bank heads, pockets, etc., the following "are interested in the enterprise, andere shareholders.Dr.A.W.Chisholm, "William Duff, Senstor Turrif, Ottawa, Mr.Pardee, M.P.ands.J.Doucet. (Sgd) S.J.DOUCETT, Mgr."

The firm is composed of S.J. Doucett, and Dr. Chisholm of this county. They are understood to have some outside capital interested.

So far as learned have not registered partnership. They are operating an old mine at this place which has been idle for about thirty years, leasing the areas from McKenzie & Mann, Toronto, who are said to own them. They started mine operating in 1918, but since that time have made very little progress. The Mines Reportfor the year ending September 1920, which is the last issue to date, showed that they raised I, I45 tons although this has likely been increased the past year. They are balieved to have invested about \$15,000. or more

Those connected are well spoken of Dr.A.W.Chisholm is regarded as possessing means, and is the Local Member for Inverness County. William Duff belongs to Lunenburg, and is a member of Parliament for that county. Doucettwas formerly employed by the Inverness Railway & Coal Co Ltd. and is said capable. The mine is located about six miles from Margaree Harbour, and the coal is shipped from that place. So far as can be ascertained, they have been meeting obligations in a satisfactory manner but the guarantee of some of these interested is suggested in credit dealings of consequence.
