Davidson at Wabigoon, informing him that there appears to be a balance of \$68.20 still payable to him out of the respective interest shares of Cape Croker Indians indebted to him. Mr A.H. Davidson of the claim made by was also informed that Mr W.F. Davidson in the matter and of the latter's reasons for asking to have payment made to the firm of Davidson and Davidson. Mr A.H. Davidson has not yet been heard from, and the Department does not feel disposed to take further action in the matter until a reply has been received from him.
