Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 10th ult. No. 879808 I have the honour to inform you that we have received a report from our Indian Agent in connection with the land reserved for this Department for hay purposes in Tps. 61 and 62 Ranges 4 and 5, W. 4. M. and have to say that in view of the report of your Land Guide Mr. Earnest Cloutier to the effect that the land is much desired for settlement purposes it has been decided to request you to cancel the said reservation. The lands therefore affected are clear as far as this Department is concerned.

In this connection I have to say that our Agent intends to visit some other lands to the North-east of Onion Lake which are reported to be suitable for the purposes of this Department. As soon as we are fully informed of their exact locality application for them will be made to your Department.
