
Ottawa, June 11, 1918.

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 24th ultimo, in regard to the residence of Mr. White on the Peguis reserve.

In reply I beg to say that the parties were allowed to remain on the reserve during the winter in order to winter their stock should now be required on the reserve, and in future you will be good enough to inform me if no white person is allowed on the reserve without the sanction of the Department.
