S/Bgt Lefeuvre asked me why I did not stop Pte Burton and I said, "Why should I stop him?" he then told me that Pte Burton was on Field Punishment.

FOURTH WITNESS

B-89433 S/Sgt Lefeuvre F.A. of the 4 Cdn Arm'd Div Ord Fd Pk RCOC having sworn states:

On the night of 22/23 Oct 44 I was Orderly Officer of the camp and at oproximately 1915 hrs I had a duty for Pte. Burton to perform which was to chop wood and keep the fire going in the Mens' Recreation Room so started to look for him. I inspected his quarters also affect the men in the quarters above Pte. Burton's if they had seem Pte. Burton and they said "If he is in, he is in the room below". I looked again on the way downstairs, shone my flashlight in Pte. Burton's room and no now was there. I then went around to the side of the building and inspected the room behind Pte. Burton's quarters which had an adjoining door. There was nobody there. I came back to the centre of the grounds and circled the whole area calling in a loud voice for Pte, Burton but received no answer. I then went to the tents of the Salvage Unit, inspected both of them and there was nobody in them. I then walkid back up the drivwary and net the two picquets namely Ptes Stevenson and Tetrauit. I asked them if they had seen Pte. Burton. Pte Stevenson said "Ics, he has just gome out the gate" so I said "why didn't you stop him" I explained that Pte Burton was doing 14 days Fleid Punishment. Pte Stevenson said "I did not know he was doing it as it has not been put in arrests." I then asked Pte Tetrault if he saw Pte Burton as far as falvage." I then said, "If you see Pte.
