DAIRY PRODUCE.
BUTTER DECLINES.
Butter prices have declined. Receipts have fallen off slightly, but will increase this week.

CHEESE STEADY.
There is no new development in the local cheese situation. Stocks are rapidly disappearing and receipts are nil.

STRAWBERRIES PLENTIFUL.
Strawberries are now arriving in large quantities and in excellent condition, principally from New York.

COUNTRY PRODUCE.
There is little change in the local egg situation. An active demand prevails, receipts are liberal and prices are about steady.

MAPLE PRODUCTS STEADY.
A steady but moderate volume of business in maple products is transacted. Stocks are adequate and prices are firm without change.

POULTRY SCARCE.
Local stocks are limited and the demand is dull. A fair trade is passing in live poultry, but fresh-killed stock is not available.

POTATOES SCARCE.
Although offerings from Eastern holders are liberal, buying is light, and local stocks are thus limited.

BEANS STEADY.
A fair business is passing and quotations are steady. Small lots are selling at \$1.70 per bushel.

FLOUR MARKET.
There is no change in the local flour situation. A steady demand prevails and prices are firm.

PROVISION MARKET (continued).
A fair trade is passing. Receipts are light and the demand is only moderate. Live hogs are selling at \$6.75 to \$7; abattoir fresh killed at \$9.50 to \$10.
