THE CAUGHNAWAGA RAILWAY—Motion—

"That the following Petitions, namely, of the Reverend James Fulton, Master of Arts, and Rural Dean, and others, of Franklin, in the County of Huntington; of the Reverend J. Dequoy, Priest, Curé of the Parish of Saint Michel Archange; and of the Reverend J. E. Perreault, Priest, and others, of the Parish of Saint Remi, in the County of Napierville; of Jean Baptiste Jodoin, and others, of the Parish of Saint Urbain; of the Reverend J. C. G. Godin, Priest, Curé of the Parish of Saint Philomène; of J. Dupuis, of the Parish of Chateauguay, in the County of Chateauguay; and of the Reverend O. Blanchard, Priest, and others of the Parish of Saint Isidore, in the County of Laprairie, be referred to a Select Committee, to consist of the Honorable Messrs. Pelletier, Ferrier, McLelan (Londonderry), Wark, Leonard, Dickson, Hope, Alexander, Bellerose, Trudel and the mover, who are to enquire into the subject of which the petitioners complain, with power to send for persons, papers and records, to report from time to time to the House, and to examine witnesses on oath, seeing that it is desirable to have recourse to that proceeding"—Mr. Bureau.

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
