SUCCESS IN GALICIA.

On the southern bank in Galicia the Russian success is even more marked. West of Trembevla the Austrians had established themselves near the vil lage of Gaivoronka on a strong fortified position which was to serve as base for an advance on the southern front. The Russian successes at Kolki and Czartosk on the Styr, alarmed the enemy and he tried to overthrow the Russians by a sudden advance from Buchach. The Russians took up excellent positions on the Styr Olyczkaikva and Sereth and by cor tinually harassing the enemy prevented him sitting down in entrenched ines. The advance from Buchach also was frustrated and the Russians in their turn flung forward from 'Iremovia on to Gaivoronka. A strong Austrian redoubt was taken. The Rus sians forced their way across Stripa, on burning bridges, and the cavalry, breaking through the enemy's lines, rounded up 2,000 prisoners and captured four guns and two machine

The striking success, which still is eing followed up, not only gives the Russians considerable strategical advantage on the southern front, but undermines any possible moral effect of Roumania of the recent large concentration of Austrian and German troops in Galicia and Bukowina near the Roumanian frontier.

Zepps RaidLondon

London, Oct. 14-Zeppelin airships have made another raid over London, dropping bombs. Eight persons are declared to have been killed and about thirty-four injured. The material dam age done is said to have been small. The Home Office shortly after midnight made the following report on

A Zeppelin raid was made Wednesday evening over a portion of the London area, when a certain number of incendiary and explosive bombs were dropped. The material damage done was small. A few fires resulted but they were quickly put out by th fire brigade. The Admiralty will issue a statement to-day when particulars
