Death of Prof. Haycock.

By the death of Professor Bruest
Haycock, which took place at his home on Acadia street on Saturday morning last, Wolfville loses a highly esteemed citizen and Acadia University a valued member of its faculty.

Prof. Heycock had been in falling health since last autumn when he had a very geyer attack of fieut trouble, and for weeks has been confined to his bed. growing gradually weaker until the end came.

The deceased was born May 29th, 1867, at Westport, where his boyhood was spent in 1839 he came to Wolfville and entered Horton Collegiate A demy, matriculating in June, 1992. The following October be entered Acadis, Culsone and graduated with the class of 1896. He spent two years at Harvard University, riceving nis B. A. degree in 1897 and the degree of M.A. in 1893. He was then appointed professor of geology and chemistry at Acadia, which position he held until 1972 when the work was divided a d he couthoused as prof. (seasor of geology. He did considerable work in the Canadian geological survey and was known as a learned geological and a thorough and successial and popular teacher. He was the author of Records of Poat-Traisne Changes in Kings County, Nova Scotia, 'The Geological History of the Gaspereau Valley,' Explorations and Investigations in the Counties of Wright and Labelle, Quebec,' etc.

Some years ago he became interested in agriculture and purchased the old Smith Harris place at Lower Wolfville, then in a run-down condition. This larm under his capaple and intelligent management has become a fine property. He took a lively interest in farming conditions generally and was of gr at assistance in the spricultural society and other organizations, where he will be much missed.

As a member of the Wolfville town Council and School Board he gave
