Scouting between the rum fleet and nore, the Gresham's searchlights st night picked out the glimmering lights of a craft that seemed ndoned. Her decks were deserted, anchor chain slapped against the tching bows, her rudder swung at will of the waves, her masts were hare of sails. A British ensign hung side down from a lanyard-the ign of distress. Under it were strung reberative signs-shirts and blanrets, shredded and frayed.

The Gresham hailed the little two master and four despairing sailors nswered They announced that they were prisoners aboard; that they had en without food and water for sevn days; that their skipper refused to nt them ashore. They praded to aptain Brockaway of the Gresham heave them a line, tow them inde the three mile limit, take possion of the Dorothy M. Smart, and ive food and water to her crew.

Captain Brockaway consented to w the craft and thus the cutter and s prize arrived to-day at the Battery where it was boarded by agents of e Department of Justice, who se'zthe twenty barrels of brandy in e vessel's hold and began an invesgation of the shanghai story.

"We shipped out of New York 23 avs ago," was Mate Coconi's tale. We were told we were signed up for the brick carrier Enterprise, sailing between New York and Cape May. hey took us at night, in a speed boat, d when we woke up next morning were on the Dorothy M. Smart, surrounded by casks of rum and in e midst of the rum fleet."

Orders to hoist sail for a voyage to falifax the sailors countered with a nce, they said. The skipper refused and so they drifted for 23 days with ails furled. The anchor was lost, and week ago the food and water ran ut, and distress signals were run up. he sailors said they might have taken ommand of the ship and sailed her nto port, but the skipper warned hem that it would be mutiny and iracv, so they watched and drifted ntil at last the Gresham came to the

Captain Gillam declared he knew thing of the shanghaiing or how his erew got aboard. All he would tell was that he came from Newfoundand, found the two master on Rum Row, apparently a derelict and took ommand of her.
