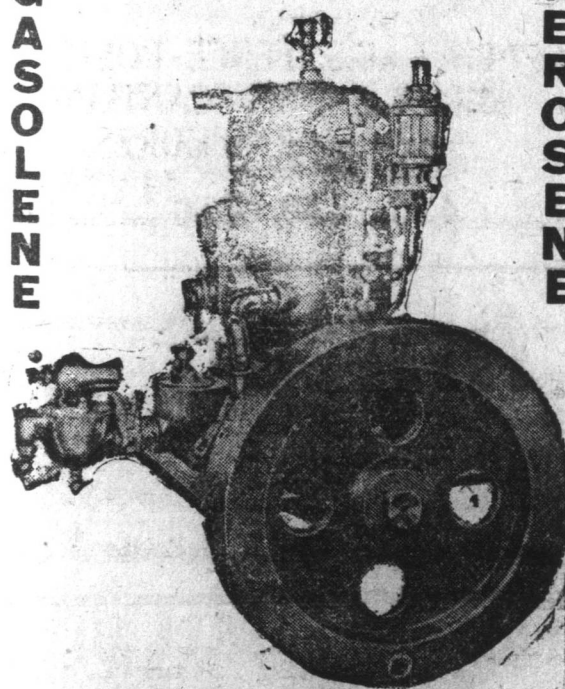

## SIDE TALKS.

### WHY THEY DIDN'T LIKE THE NEW BOY.



A new little boy had come to our neighborhood. He was a bright appearing youngster, up and coming, polite and good looking, but I noticed that he did not seem to be much with the other boys, and when I asked my nephew how he liked him, he showed a distinct lack of enthusiasm.

When I inquired further, he was evasive and inarticulate, as children, and especially boys, always are when you ask them about their thoughts and feelings.

But finally I got what I think was the hub of the trouble.

That instinctive resentment.

"Oh, yes, he's smart, and nice enough, but he's always showing off. He makes us sick. I wish he'd stop it. He'd be all right if he wouldn't show off so much."

How instinctive and deep rooted is that dislike of the person who is always showing off. The smallest children feel it. And they never get over it, either.

I think there are few tendencies that parents owe to their children's future, to nip in the bud, more than the tendency to show off unduly.

I say "unduly" because all children (and grown ups too) will show off sometimes under some conditions.

When the new little girl comes to town, the little boy next door will, of course, walk on the high fence and jump off the shed roof, and order his little sister around, for her benefit.

Always Playing To The Gallery.

But to be constantly trying to make an impression on someone, to talk and act most of the time with an eye on the gallery, to be always trying to grab the centre of the stage, to be constantly saying and doing things just for effect, are ways that do not endear either the child or the grown up.

Children are tremendously responsive to flattery and attention. They have not the sense of proportion, the experience, to know what often lies behind these attentions, and how easily flattery can become behind-the-back criticism or mimicry. The bait almost always gets them. They show off and perhaps never realize until years later what a show they must have made of themselves.

Years Afterwards She Blushes.

A friend of mine once told me that though she is a middle aged woman, she still sometimes blushes to remember a time when she was led on by some older folks to talk about the books she had read, and to show off in a most disgusting fashion. "I didn't realize until years afterwards what a frightful little fool I made of myself," she said. "I suppose I did the same sort of thing other times but that was the worst. I'm going to teach my children never to show off, if I don't teach them another thing."

Of course grown ups often show off as badly as children, but if they were made to realize in their childhood the bad taste and the inevitable bad impression created by the habit, they would learn to control the instinct more carefully.

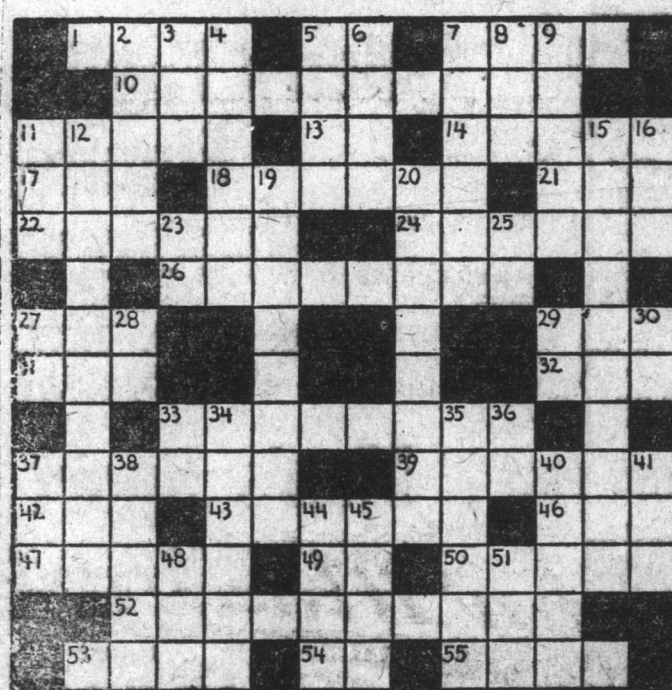
Something to Eat Anyhow.—His wife had gone to visit her mother, and had telephoned that she would not be returning until the morning.
