To Kill Ants.

Dear Miss Grey: Would you kindig advise me in (1) What to do to get rid of black ants in a kitchen, especially on the table? 2. How to wash a sweater coat (white with dark blue cuffs and collar)? 3. I am moving into a new house the first of the month, would it be too late to plant flowers and a few vegetables? If not, what kind of flowers do you think are nicer for the front, and what for the back? Thanking you in advance, ANXIOUS.

A.—I If possible find where the ants come into the house, and place carbolic acid near the crevice; when washing the table drop a little carbolic in the water. 2. I would not advise you to wash the coat, as the blue is apt to run. Get some commeal and rub well into the wool; then brush; two or three rubbings may be necessary to remeve all the dirt. 3. I think you would still have success with beets, potatoes, cabbages and tomatoes. Buy a box of the latter from a gardener and transplant them. Salvia, asters, stocks, pansies, and petunlas may also be purchased from a gardener and set out into the ground.
