

Tursday, Sept. 28th—Tritting—Purse 9150; 3100 to first, 40 to second, 19 to third. Open to all horses that never beat 2.55 prior to Sept. 18,


Running - Purse \$125—Ord and an eighth mile, single dash, \$100 and character returned to first, 25 and entrance returned to second. Entrance only \$5. To carry 100 lbs, with an allowance of 7 lbs to all horses fred in the Dominion of Canada, and to all horses that have not won a race this season.

SECOND DAY.

WEDNESDAY, Scott. 29—Hurdle Race—Purse \$250—Two mile dish, over 8 hurdles 3 ft. 6 in. high; \$185 and entrance returned to first, 50 and entrance returned to third. Entrance only \$5. Handicap; weight to be also unced Sept. 27.

Trotting—Purse \$350, \$225 to first, 100 to second, 25 to third; open to all horses that never best 2:35 prior to Sept. 18, 1875.

Running—Purse \$225—\$165 and entrance returned to first, 60 and entrance returned to second. Entrance only \$10; man heats, 2 in 3.



THURSDAY, Sept. 30 Trotting—Purse \$550; \$350 to first, 150 to scond, 50 to third; open

Running—Purse \$50; \$275 and entrance returned to first, 755 and entrance returned to second. Entrance couly \$10; 11 mile neats, 2 in 3. The winner of the mile heat race to carry 7 lbs extra.

Steeplechase—Purin 9350—Over a course about 21 miles. Handingp. Weights to be announced Sept. 29th, after the Hurdle Race. \$250 and entrance returned to act, 75 and entrance returned to second, 25 and entrance returned to third; entrance only \$5.


