The time that elapses between the notification to the challenged State and the completion of the negotiations concerning the perimeter and the actual entry of the inspection team into the area where it is to begin its work must be kept to the minimum compatible with the resolution of the difficulties there are to be overcome: the negotiations concerning the perimeter, while probably the greatest problem and the greatest point of concern for legitimate security reasons, can be reduced in importance if it is borne in mind that controlled access techniques are an effective means of catering to those security concerns and can thus lessen the drama of negotiating the final perimeter.
