Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to your Excellency's Note of today's date which in English reads:

"Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics for Cooperation in the Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy signed at Moscow on this date (hereinafter referred to as the "Cooperation Agreement").

Within the scope of the Cooperation Agreement, Canada and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics wish to continue their nuclear cooperation involving the enrichment of uranium obligated to Canada in enrichment facilities of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.

To this end, I have the honour to propose that, unless otherwise agreed by the parties:

(a) where nuclear material that originates in or is subject to a nuclear cooperation agreement with one of the Parties to the Cooperation
