HE IS A GRADUATE OF CHARLES UNIVERSITY IN PRAGUE. HE JOINED THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN TRADE IN 1951 AND SERVED IN ITALY AS COMMERCIAL ATTACHE FROM 1952 TO 1955. HE ATTENDED VARIOUS ECONOMIC CONFERENCES AS HEAD OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATION. IN 1959 DR. TAUER JOINED THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS IN THE CAPACITY OF ENOVY EXTRAOR-DINARY AND MINISTER PLENIPOTENTIARY.
