REV. DR. JAMES M. KING.

In view of the *dangerous elements* of Jesuit instruction in national education are we not ready for the following platform for this continent :—Christian morality in the instruction of the youth, as a preparation for responsible and loyal citizenship, and as the historic and actual basis of our national institutions; no sectarian perversion of the fund designed for the common education of our citizenship; no foreign dictation to the voters of the nations; no church and state in our legislation: but un-sectarian schools for the future citizens, and an inquiry into the sort of education given in all institutions having legal sanction or receiving public money, and the outlawing of all nurseries of intolerance and disloyalty as measures of self-preservation of national life.
