

V.—TRUSTEES.

(1) There shall be three Hall Trustees of this Lodge, one of whom shall be elected by ballot at the regular annual election of officers of this Lodge, and shall hold office for the three ensuing years, or until his successor is elected.

(2) The duties of the Trustees shall be to take charge of The Temple erected jointly by the I. O. O. F. and A. F. and A. M. Societies of the town. The said Trustees to act in conjunction with three Trustees from the I.O.O.F. Lodge, with power to lease the same, collect rents, pay taxes, insurance, interest, and general repairs, and to exercise a general supervision over the affairs of the said Temple.

(3) The Trustees to pay all dividends to the Treasurer; the Trustees to furnish the Lodge with a written report annually at the meeting preceding the election of officers; the Trustees to give the Lodge a guarantee bond if requested, the Lodge to pay for the same.

VI —CLOTHING.

Brethren shall at all times appear when in Lodge in proper Masonic Clothing, as prescribed by the Book of Constitution.

VII.—VISITORS.

No visitor shall speak to any question without leave of the Master, nor shall he on any occasion be allowed to vote. During his continuance in the Lodge he shall be subject to its By-laws.
