

MASONIC CLOTHING and INSIGNIA.

The following Masonic Clothing and Insignia shall be worn by the Craft ; and no Brother shall, on any pretence, be admitted into the Grand Lodge, or any subordinate Lodge without his proper Clothing.

If any honorary or other jewel be worn, it must be conformable to, and consistent with those degrees which are recognised by the Grand Lodge.

JEWELS.

<i>Masters of Lodges</i> ,.....	The Square.
<i>Past Masters</i> ,.....	The Square and the Diagram of the 47 Prop. 1st Book of Euclid, engraven on a silver plate, pendant within it.
<i>Senior Warden</i> ,.....	The Level.
<i>Junior Warden</i> ,.....	The Plumb.
<i>Treasurer</i> ,.....	The Key.
<i>Secretary</i> ,.....	The Cross Pens.
<i>Deacons</i> ,.....	The Dove.
<i>Inner Guard</i> ,.....	Cross Swords.
<i>Tyler</i> ,.....	The Sword.

The above to be in silver ; the Collars to be light blue ribbon, four inches broad ; if silver chain be used, it must be placed on the light blue ribbon.
