## An Act to amend the Railway Act, 1903.

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Consel lows :---

Section 227 of *The Railway Act*, 1903, is amended by 1903, c. 58, s.
striking out the word "or" in the third line and substituting <sup>227</sup> amended. therefor the word "and," and by adding after the word "expedient" at the end of the section the words, "and wherever in a city, town or incorporated village a railway crosses a highway at rail-level, the said speed of ten miles an hour shall in
no event be exceeded, unless the railway company keeps a watchmen at such crossing to warn all persons using the high.
