

An Act to amend the Railway Act, 1903.

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Section 227 of *The Railway Act*, 1903, is amended by 1903, c. 58, s.
5 striking out the word “or” in the third line and substituting 227 amended.
therefor the word “and,” and by adding after the word “expedient” at the end of the section the words, “and wherever
in a city, town or incorporated village a railway crosses a highway at rail-level, the said speed of ten miles an hour shall in
10 no event be exceeded, unless the railway company keeps a watchman at such crossing to warn all persons using the highway of approaching trains.”
