GREENSEAL WINS FEATURE EQUALS TRACK RECORD

Juggler, Favorite, is Beaten in Feature Race at New Orleans.

NEW ORLEANS, March 5.—Greenswood equaled the track record for 11-1/8 miles at the Fair Grounds to-day, by winning

the fourth race in 1:43.34. Greenleaf, a 3-year-old, was the only horse to break the 1:40 barrier. Bandita finished second in the third race after being almost left at the post.
