Oranges—The orange market is very firm at unchanged prices, as the supply is expected to be rather limited for Christmas. The California navel oranges are selling at \$5 to \$5.50 per case; late Valencia at \$4.25 to \$5 per case; Florida and Florida navel at \$4.75 to \$5 per case.

Tomatoes—Hothouse tomatoes have not been very plentiful the past week, and the No. 2's have been very low grade. No. 1's selling at 25c to 30c per lb., and No. 2's at 15c to 18c per lb.

Cucumbers—The hothouse cucumbers have been noted for their absence the past week, none of the Leamington variety coming in.
