The idea of a "good road day" in Calais, advanced by its new and energetic board of trade, had its first try-out last Thursday and the citizens are satisfied that it was a good idea and well worth repeating. Mayor Fowler led off in the work and all were operating under the general direction of John E. McPaul, chairman of the committee of the board of trade. The Eastern Pulpmong Co., through its manager, Walter L. Cobb, donated use of its seven trucks and the following sent a truck each: J. H. Hanson & Sons, Arthur Smith, Brackett & Co., W. R. BOOZE, BONUSES, RURAL CREDITS AND EDUCATION
Resume of the Work of the Ontario Legislature at Last Session—The second Longest on Record.

(Toronto, May 9.—(By Canadian Press)—Following a "long and tiresome session" as it was described by Premier E. C. Drury, the second session of the fifteenth legislature of Ontario concluded in the early hours of the last day of April. Opening on January 25, the House has been open 63 days which constituted the longest session but one in the history of the province. In the first year of the Whitney administration the Legislature closed after seventy days of session. The session was when they voted themselves a bonus of \$600, entailing an expense of \$67,000.

Farmers have no cause to complain regarding the crop of legislation beneficial to themselves which they have harvested.

Hon. Manning Doherty, minister of agriculture, safely piloted three bills through the house establishing a system of rural credits by which farmers can obtain both long and short term loans. Then again members from rural constituencies may put themselves on the back in the dying hours of the session the government came across with a bill which provides for housing rural transmission lines for hydro power to the extent of not exceeding fifty per cent. of the cost. This measure also provides that part of the revenue secured from water rentals at Niagara Falls may be used for the benefit of rural hydro consumers.
