Kingston, Ont., June 18.—When Wellington Babcock, farmer, aged forty, of Wilton, was refused in his attempt to get his wife to come to live with him again after being separated for over a year, he drew a revolver and shot himself in the temple. Death was almost instantaneous. Before shooting himself he fired several shots and two of them came within an inch of hitting his wife.

The train was delayed some time by the accident.





Gloucester Going Dry.


