

SHORTENS MAIL ROUTE TO NORTH PACIFIC COAST BY MORE THAN TWO DAYS.

Residents in the busy little city of Prince Rupert, British Columbia, are enjoying this week for the first time the benefits of a direct mail service with the East. Postal service over the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway between Edmonton and Prince Rupert has just been inaugurated and a great saving of time is being effected. Hitherto the mails have been taken from Prince Rupert and other coast points to Vancouver by steamer and then sent east by rail. Under the new arrangement of direct service over the G. T. P. there will be a clear saving of two, and possibly three days time. A letter posted in Montreal or New York should be in Prince Rupert within five days. Via Vancouver it would have taken at the very least seven days.

Prince Rupert is destined to be an important stopping place on the shortest route around the world, for a scheme that has for its ultimate object the swift circling of the Globe must reckon the city on its right of way. The distance from Liverpool to Yokohama by this route is 10,983 miles as against 10,858 via New York and San Francisco. Moreover, ships sailing from Prince Rupert, pass, with a few strokes from the land-locked harbor to the high seas, and begin their journey across the Pacific 600 miles nearer the East than a ship would by sailing at the same time from any other Pacific port.

GERMAN RUIN CERTAIN

Rome, Oct. 29—Signor Pantaleoni, a prominent Italian economist, examining the probable financial situation of the belligerents at the end of the war, considers that Germany and Austria, whether vanquished or victorious, will be ruined. Unless Germany destroys the British fleet, Germany will have lost her colonies, her predominant commercial position in China and her trade with America.

MRS. DE SOLA BEREAVED.

Rabbi Samuel, Her Father, Had Illustrious Career in London.

(Montreal Gazette.)

A cablegram from London, received yesterday announced the death of the Rev. Isaac Samuel, father of Mrs. Melodia De Sola, wife of Rabbi De Sola, of Montreal. The deceased was senior minister of the Bayswater Synagogue for fifty years, and retired only a few months ago. He was in his eighty-second year.

Rabbi Samuel, who celebrated his golden jubilee last year as senior minister of the Bayswater Synagogue in London, was born and educated in that city, into the hearts of whose people of all shades of opinion, he had won his way. For many years he was a member of the faculty of Jews' College, which is one of the foremost educational institutions in the world. The present Jews' Deaf and Dumb Home in London owes its life in no small measure to the late rabbi, who acted as honorary secretary of the home during a period extending over half a century; and he was one of those who were instrumental in the erection of the present magnificent building. Another monument to his zeal for the welfare of his people is the Home for Aged Jews; as well as the Holiday Home for Working Girls at Broadstairs. Both these institutions are considered to be among the finest of their kind in England.
