MAKING NUT MUFFINS.

Two cupfuls of flour, half a teaspoonful of salt, three tablespoonfuls of baking pewder, one cupful of milk, half a cupful of chopped nut meats, two eggs, two table spoonfuls of sugar, three tablespoonfuls of melted butter, and half a teaspoonful of wanila extract. Mix and sift the dry ingredients, then add the beaten yokes of eggs, butter, and milk. Beat well, add the vanilla extract and the stiffly beaten whites of the eggs. Divide into buttered and floured gem pans and bake in a hot oven for twenty minutes.

From four to six hard cooked eggs, lettuce leaves, mayonnaise sauce, olive oil, vinegar, tarragon and chervil leaves and parsley. Shell and cut the eggs into slices. Line a salad dish with small lettuce leaves, pour over a layer of mayonnaise dressing; upon this neatly arrange the slices of egg, pour over a few drops of oil and vinegar. Sprinkle over some finely chopped tarragon and chervil leaves and parsley.
