Defending Officer's address:

"Mr. President & members of this Court, I think that according to law, the onus is on the prosecutor to prove that the accused left with the intention of never coming back. The prosecution has proved that Gen. Hammar has been A.W.O.L. for a few months, but not that he was a deserter. The fact that he was apprehended in civilian clothes does not prove, in my view, his intention to desert His Majesty's Service. In his own words, he told the Court, that whenever he was going out, except when going to work, he wore his military uniform."

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
