A. Survey Officer.
- Q. Do you have a staff under you?
A. Yes.
- Q. Are there any more Svy Offrs in the Regt?
A. No, just one.
- Q. What does your staff comprise?
A. 1 Sgt and 8 O.Rs.
- Q. How many vehicles?
A. The establishment calls for four.
- Q. Is Gnr. Gunn in the svy staff?
A. No.
- Q. As Svy Offr is it your responsibility to train the Svy Section?
A. Yes.
- Q. Were you satisfied with the training you gave that section?
A. As far as the technical knowledge they knew their work, but as far as practical training I was not satisfied.
- Q. What do you mean by that?
A. I was not in the field with the whole section.
- Q. Why would that be?
A. They were usually on other duties or fatigues.
- Q. Would that be the personnel or vehicles?
A. The vehicles were usually duty trucks.
- Q. What other work did you do in the Regiment?
A. The Svy Offr at RHQ was also required to be Billeting Offr. Until about 6 months ago I had that job, and also acted as Messing Officer. I also was Mess Secretary of R.H.Q.
