

6. Resolved, That section eighty-nine of the said Act be hereby amended by striking out the following words, "To District Registrars, not exceeding \$1,000."

The said Resolutions, being read a second time, were agreed to.

The Order of the Day being read, for the third reading of the Bill to amend "The Liquor License Act, 1883 ;"

Sir John A. Macdonald moved, seconded by Sir Leonard Tilley, and the Question being proposed, That the Bill be now read the third time;

Mr. McCraney moved, in amendment, seconded by Mr. Somerville (Brant), That all the words after "now" to the end of the Question, be left out, and the words, "re-committed to a Committee of the Whole House, with power to amend the same by inserting in Sub-section Two, Section Twenty-five, after the word 'no,' the words "'Hotel or,'" inserted instead thereof;
