

VII. That when the judgment appealed from shall <sup>In ejectment;</sup> be in an action of ejectment, the security required by the last preceding rule shall be taken in double the yearly value of the property in question; and in cases where the matter in question shall relate to the taking <sup>or question relating to rent, &c.</sup> of any annual or other rent, customary or other duty or fee, or any other such like demand of a general and public nature, affecting future rights, the amount in which security shall be taken in addition to the security required for costs shall be fixed by order of a judge of the court appealed from.

VIII. That the security required by the two last <sup>To be by bond, unless otherwise directed.</sup> preceding rules shall be given by bond, and the recitals and condition in such bond shall be such as shall conform to the provisions of the said two rules, with such further or other conditions, in cases where the judgment is not for the payment of a sum of money only, as the judge approving such security may think fit to order.

IX. That the parties to such bond, as sureties, <sup>Affidavit of justification of sureties.</sup> shall, by affidavit respectively, make oath that they are resident householders or freeholders in Upper Canada, and severally worth the sum mentioned in such bond, over and above what will pay and satisfy all their debts; which affidavit may be in the following form:—
