The Superintendent addressed the Indians
Children. Your Great Father at Quebec has directed
me to call you together for the purpose
of stating to you, that Your Great Father
on the other side of the Great Water is
desirous of getting from you, for the
purpose of facilitating the communi-
cation with his Settlements above
this, a Tract of Land, contained within
a line along the Thunderbolt Bay, &
the River Hautanway rising until it
intersects Lake Huron, & described in
the sketch now shown to you marked
Nos 1. & 2.
