The Committee of the Privy Council have had before them a report, dated 30th May, 1922, from the Honourable the Secretary of state for External Affairs, to whom was referred a despatch, dated the 19th May, 1922, from the Secretary of State for the Colonies, pointing out that the term of office for which the Honourable Peter C. Larkin was appointed by Minute of the Privy Council approved by Your Excellency on the 15th April, 1922 to succeed Sir George Perley on the Executive Council of the Imperial Institute, expired on the 26th May, 1922.

The Secretary of State for External Affairs recommends that the Honourable Mr. Larkin be re-appointed under Paragraph 4 of the Schedule to the Imperial Institute (Management) Act, 1916, on the Executive Council of the Imperial Institute for the period of three years dating from the 26th May, 1922.

The Committee, concurring, advise that Your Excellency may be pleased to communicate the substance of this Minute, by telegraph, to the Right Honourable the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

All of which is respectfully submitted for Your Excellency's approval.
