
Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of the quarterly returns and requisitions for the salaries of the teachers on the Tyendinaga reserve and in reply I beg to inform you that the amount of quarterly salary as requisitioned for by you is correct, except in the cases of the teachers of the Western and Central schools. Being both new teachers, these are not entitled to any salary for the summer holidays just past and are only paid from the time school reopened, August 17, last, till the end of the quarter, 33 teaching days. There are 316 teaching days in the year and these teachers are paid ³³ 316 of their yearly salary. Should they complete the year, they will be paid the balance.

For the current quarter, provided they teach the full time, they will draw the amount requisitioned by you for the September quarter. Cheques will be sent you for the teachers for the quarter ^{last}.

In future separate requisitions in duplicate should be made for each school.
