
Ottawa, 2nd November, 1904.

Sir,-

In reply to a letter from your office of the 27th ultimo respecting circular covering the quantity of hay to be put up having been sent to Stony Reserve, I beg to say that it was not sent by mistake. The Department had in mind cattle not horses when this circular was sent that Agency. That portion of it that refers to horses may not apply at the Stony Reserve but until the Inspector's report is to hand no further action will be taken.
