Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 16th instant in reference to Eabouli Settlement school, and in reply to inform you that as the work is now progressing favourably, it will be necessary for you to give the it careful oversight, inspecting the building frequently that the work done may be in accordance with the plans and specifications in every particular.

It will also be necessary for you to issue interim certificates for payment equal to 90% of the value of the work done and for materials worked and actually used in the building.

The certificates issued are to be sent to the Department, in duplicate, for payment, stating thereon the value of the work done, and noting particularly that 90% only of the value of the work shown is to be paid.

A model certificate is included with the forms sent under separate registered cover for your information.
