I think it will be quite difficult for you to consider the Argentine proposal (3), but since they must have some agreement or other, I think the best plan to insure Argentina's maintenance of the status quo to the greatest possible extent would be to find a way out (word missing) (1) and (2); for instance, to make the counter proposal that Argentine ships coming from Argentina to Calcutta to load hemp sacks should call in secretly at the Andaman Islands which are on their return route and are within the area dominated by us; there we could supply them with arms which we have available. If you have any ideas on the subject please let me have them at once. I have so far not revealed this to the German and Italian representatives here.

When you receive this message wire back the plain language phrase "koseki jittei shussei seri".

When you broadcast official cypher messages, switch over to a transmitting aerial beamed on South America as soon as the general news broadcast is finished. Also please keep the transmitting speed at fifteen words a minute and collate.
