complete, than shall the glory of the Lord come upon, fill the whole house.

As the various pieces that are put into a house in construction differ in form and use, so that they show resemblance to each other, and yet each is needed in place for which it is intended and fitted, so do the included at the stones which make up the temple of God, differ freach other. Every peculiarity of personality or excepticity is used of God to fill a place in the whole. Let not try to be alike; let none try to make himself another. Let each be himself, assured that God has making what he is, to fit the place. He has designed him fill. Only is it necessary that each should be yielded to the purpose of the great Architect.

Since each stone in the temple is a temple in itself shows in what diverse temples God can dwell. He dake up His abode in all the diversified characterist which mark the dwellers in all parts of the world, and all grades of social or national life. But while the stor of the temple of God may differ, one thing is essential that each shall be a temple, and himself indwelt of God

And what is true of the individual, is true also local assemblies. There are as many different kinds Churches, as there are of individuals. It is a mistake insist upon uniformity of Church organization, or method A Church composed of the educated, cultured and wealth citizens of an enlightened land, will need one form an order, and a Church composed of the illiterate and uncivized will need quite another; and between these there we be needed a variety of forms. It is for this reason that
