

The Provincial Gaol, which was recently erected at a cost of over \$100,000, employs a large staff.

A well-equipped Hospital, with capacity for twenty patients, ensures the best of modern treatment for medical and surgical cases. It is Government aided and Government supervised.

The Town Hall—one of the largest buildings—is centrally situated, and comprises an Opera Hall, with a seating capacity of over 600, the Post Office, Fire Hall, and Council Chambers. It was built at a cost of \$40,000.

A Water-Works system, based upon an inexhaustible artesian supply located in the centre of the town, furnishes the very best of water for domestic purposes, and provides adequate fire protection. In addition to stand pipes and hydrants throughout the business section of the town, the fire protection system comprises a chemical engine, high pressure engine, hose, reels, and other necessary equipment. The fire and drainage system represent an outlay of \$40,000.

The town is lighted by an Acetylene Gas Plant, which furnishes an excellent light to public and private buildings, and supplies gas for a high-class street-lighting service.
