

Exercise.—PROVISIONS BILL.

Instructions to Pupil.—Write the following Bill according to the Model on page 20:—Victoria, November 17, 1902. Jos. Alderson, Bought of Wm. Mitchell & Co.,—5 lbs. Rib Roast @ 11c., 2 lbs. Pork Chops @ 10c., 1 Turkey 15 lbs. @ 11c., 1 can Peas @ 10c., 2 bags Potatoes @ 45c., 3 bunches Beets 10c., 3 bunches Celery @ 10c., 1 pk. Parsnips @ 20c., $\frac{1}{2}$ bu. Apples @ 60c., 2 qts. Mixed Pickles @ 10c., 1 btl. Radish @ 15c. Paid Nov. 29, 1902.

Observation.—Note the difference between 3 bunches Beets 10c. and 3 bunches Celery @ 10c.
