We require from all parties unknown to us a first-class written reference or deposit of \$5.00 or over. We prefer a reference from some dealer or collector. No Postals noticed. Promptness a prominent feature. We desire collectors to give this method of purchasing for their collection a trial, and we are convinced that when it has been once tried they will buy only in this manner.

OUR DISCOUNT SHEETS.

These sheets are more especially prepared for the younger collector—he who has less than 5000 varieties in his collection, and for the purpose of selling to other collectors. The stamps are on sheets, range in price from one cent to one dollar. The stamps as a rule are classified according to price, but some are classified according to country—South and Central American countries, Great Britain, Mexico and the Br. Colonials. These are classified according to country, and special selections of these places can be secured on application. The stamps are as a rule marked at Scott's catalogue prices, but in many cases range far below. A discount of 33 1/3% is allowed on all sales, and purchases from these sheets amounting to 50 cents or over. No discounts allowed in cases where less than 50 cents worth is taken. In many cases customers dispose of the entire selection of sheets sent them. In such case a special discount of 50% is allowed. As with our Net Sheets, we require with every application for sheets a first-class Philatelic reference from some well known dealer or collector, or when inconvenient to give this class of reference your postmaster will do. - These Rules pertain to both Net and Discount Sheets.*
- I.—We forward every selection of sheets sent out by registered mail, and collectors are requested to return sheets in same manner.
 - II.—Sheets must be returned in good order within ten days.
 - III.—REMITTANCES—Amounts under 50 cents in unused stamps of lowest denomination. Over that amount, remittances must be made by Post Office or American Express Order. Personal cheques not acceptable.
