Witness his composition—his peace—his soul is stayed upon God ; the love of God is shed abroad in his heart—the opening Heavens are shining upon him with beams of celestial light—the tokens of His goodness, which had abdicated for 100 years, fell down, and the robes of light, which had been cast off, shone again in all their brightness, and the light of the sun, moon, and stars, and the stars of the firmament, all shone upon him, and he died in the presence of the angels of God.
