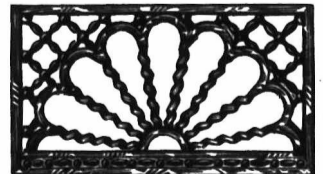
High Park—There is a ten-minute service on College and Yonge direct into the park.
