TEACHER RESIGNED.—Miss Lang, one of the recently appointed teachers in the Public School, tendered her resignation to the Board last week, which was accepted at a special meeting of the Board held on Saturday. Mrs. De Bell, a former teacher in the school, to the vacant position, at a salary of \$225 per annum, an advance of \$25 over the salary paid Miss Lang. In the interest of the school it is to be hoped that this frequent changing of teachers, which has been the outcome of the policy adopted by the present Board will not be allowed to continue. It is very questionable wisdom to sacrifice the interests of the school for the sake of saving a few dollars, and that such has been done is quite apparent from the amount of time which has been lost to the pupils through these frequent changes, not to take into consideration the greater efficiency naturally to be expected from teachers commanding better salaries. The advance which has just been made would indicate that the Board has discovered that its short sighted policy is not the thing, and its members are evidently prepared to abandon the form of false economy which they have inaugurated. Better to get wisdom late than never, but wisdom acquired after patience is sometimes too dearly bought. Looking the stable door over the steed has been stolen is not suggestive of the perspicacity with which those who have charge of the interests of education are presumed to be endowed.
