Heretofore Mr. Hooson, the provincial constable, has been acting as health officer, and now, owing to the large increase in population and increased area, as well as a consideration of Mr. Hooson's other dutics, I would suggest the ad-visability of the council appointing an assistant sanitary officer to Officer Hooson to enable him to carry out the work as rapidly and as efficaci-ously as possible. I might suggest that, in my opinion, the best plan to adopt is to cause each householder within the city limits to scrape together all garbage in a heap, and where it is in a moist condition to have it sprinkled with chloride of lime or com-mon lime, and as soon as it dries, or if it is already dry, to cause them to burn it or remove it to some specified garbage dump, where the whole can be destroyed by fire by the direction of the health officer, Mr. Hooson. I might also remind the council that com-plaints have been made concerning dead ani-mals lying about the streets and alleys.
