Kent Case Decided

Friday Justice Barry gave judgment in the following case tried before him without a jury at the recent Carleton County Circuit.

Florence L. Sullivan vs. The Trustees of School District No. 11, in the Parish of Kent. This is an action for the trover and conversion of a mare, claimed to be the property of the plaintiff, which the defendants seized and sold in June, 1917, under an execution for school taxes against Daniel Sullivan, the plaintiff's husband. Judgment and verdict for the plaintiff for \$225, with the costs of the action. F. C. Squires and M. L. Hayward for the plaintiff; J. C. Hartley, K. C., for the defendants.

Potato-Houses Burn

William W. Boyer's potato-house on his farm on the boundary-line road, Fort Fairfield, was burned about 5:00 o'clock Monday morning from a fire that is thought to have started from a defective flue. With the potato-house were burned 3,000 barrels of potatoes and some other goods. The total loss is estimated at about \$16,000. The potatoes were not insured, but some insurance was carried on the other property destroyed. — Review

A large potato warehouse, containing 4,000 barrels of potatoes, owned by W. S. York, at Mars Hill Aroostook, was burned with contents on Friday. A quantity of grain and flour was also burned. The loss is \$40,000.
