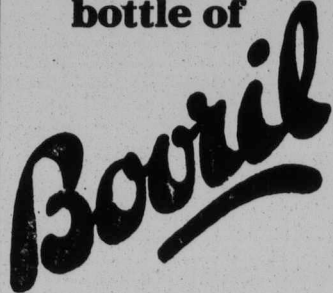

some of the grain interests, was ab-
solutely groundless. Sir George ex-
pressed himself as perfectly satisfied
with the work of the wheat board in
marketing Canadian wheat, and spoke
optimistically of the result of the pool-
ing arrangement which had been
decided upon. He reiterated that the
policy of the Government was not a
permanent one.

**Students Trap
Firebug At St.
Xavier College**

Students Trap Firebug.
Sydney, Nov. 11.—The S. F. X.
College firebug was caught redhanded
at the college yesterday. He is a
young student belonging to Cape Bre-
ton. He was led into a trap by two
other boys who pretended to act as
his accomplices in another attempt to
burn the college down. He was
caught in the basement getting ready
to set another fire last night. The
boy, who is now in jail, has confessed
to setting fire on September 25th
which damaged one of the college
buildings but was discovered in time
to prevent the building being destroy-
ed. He also stated that he intended
to use dynamite as well as fire this
time. When pressed for his motive
for setting fire to the college the boy
said he wanted to get home.

**VENDORS MAY BUY
FROM ANY LEGAL
WHOLESALE HOUSE**

Fredericton, N. B., Nov. 12.—"The
government will not seek to restrict
licensee vendors from purchasing
liquor from any source where they
can legally do so," declared Premier
Foster in an official statement this
morning. He announced that the
government had refused to accept
the proposal that retail vendors in
New Brunswick should be confined
to making their purchases from the
wholesalers at St. John.

**Latest Type Of
Tourist Cars**

One of the Features in
Canadian National Railways'
Daily Service
Toronto-Winnipeg-Vancouver

The Canadian National daily trans-
continental train, Toronto-Winnipeg-
Vancouver made its initial trip from
Toronto, with one of the very latest
type of steel tourist cars as part of its
equipment, the first of an order of
twenty such cars in whose construc-
tion every point has been considered
for the safety and comfort of passen-
gers. This modern type of tourist
car, with antileakage device in of
similar design to the standard sleep-
ing coach, the exception being they
are upholstered in leather instead of
plush.

Electrically lighted throughout, all
berths, upper and lower, are provided
with berth lamps. A new feature for
this class of car is that lamps have
been installed under the seats in
the aisles of the car, so that when the
ceiling lamps are turned out for the
night light may be provided under
berth curtains, a great convenience
for passengers when going through
the car.

Phosphorous push buttons can be
readily seen in the dark, should the
passenger require to switch on the
light or ring the bell, when the berth
is in darkness.

A safety feature introduced is a
device for holding down the upper
berth which precludes any possibility
of the upper berth closing when in
use. Separate berth curtains are pro-
vided so that passengers in the upper
berths will not disturb passengers in
the lower.

The kitchen has the latest steel ran-
ge, facilities for washing dishes, and
lockers enable passengers to store
their food. Lavatories have received
special attention, and provide greater
conveniences than the older type.
An electric thermostatic heating con-
trol can be so adjusted as to regulate
the temperature of the car, thus pre-
venting overheating.

Thus with the introduction of the
daily service of the Canadian National
trains between Toronto-Winnipeg-Van-
couver, is the added convenience of
the second-class passengers who can
enjoy a transcontinental trip in every
comfort at minimum expense.
