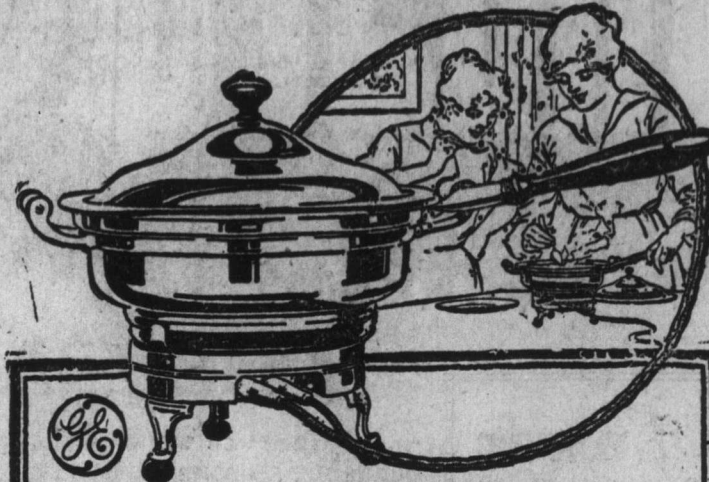

April, 1915, and the second about
June, 1915.
